Site Fee Charge: The site fee charge for rehearsal dinners is \$500, for the time period of 5-8pm.

Menu Selection: Menu selection must be made no later than 14 days prior to event. At this time the final headcount must be noted as well. The bill will reflect this final count as the guaranteed number of guests, or the total number served; whichever is greater.

Food and Beverage Minimum:

January 1st to May 15th: \$1500 May 16h to October 30th: \$2000

October 31st to December 31st: \$1500

Food and beverage minimums do not include taxes and fees. Holiday weekends subject to \$2000 minimum.

Food and Beverage: All food and beverages must be purchased and prepared through the Waterville Valley Golf Club. No outside alcoholic beverages may be brought onto the premises.

Tax and Fee: A 3% administrative fee and 8.5% NH Meals and Rental Tax are added to all dining functions.

Media and Entertainment: We welcome video presentations to make your event personal. Please discuss options to coordinate with the golf course's event planner in advance. Customized playlists can be sent for listening during the evening, or our house background music is standard.

Decorations: Parties are welcome to bring decorations and/or table settings and are responsible for setup/cleanup of such. Candles are not permitted.
